



## Code Page

Characters are represented by character codes. Character codes are generated and stored when a user inputs a document. A Code Page is a list of selected character codes in a certain order. Code Pages are usually defined to support specific languages or groups of languages which share common writing systems. For example, Code Page 1253 for Windows 95/98/NT provides character codes required in the Greek writing system. Traditionally, a font has been designed to contain all the glyphs required by a single Code Page. The order of the character codes in a Code Page allows the system to provide the appropriate character code to an application when a user presses a key on the keyboard. When a new Code Page is loaded, different character codes are provided to the application.

Unicode TrueType fonts allows In Windows 95/98/NT, change of Code Pages on-the-fly by the user, without changing the default language system in use.



## Кодови таблици

Знаците и символите се представят чрез кодове. Когато потребителят въвежда текст системата го интерпретира в кодове на знаци и символи. Кодова таблица (Code Page) е последователност от определени кодове.

Кодовите таблици служат за поддържане на специфични езици или група от езици с еднакъв езиков произход. Така например, Code Page 1253 за Windows 95/98 е набор от кодове на знаци и символи, необходими за работа на гръцки език. Една кодова таблица е подмножество на шрифта. Подредбата на кодовете в Кодовата таблица определя достъпа на системата и приложения продукт до точно определен знак при натискане на съответния клавиш. Когато се зареди нова Кодова таблица се присвоява ново съответствие.

В Windows 95/98 различните Кодови таблици могат да бъдат превключвани без да се сменя езиковата среда на системата.
